Foreclosure can be very scary and daunting for homeowners. The Foreclosure Prevention Project staff attorneys and paralegals works with homeowners of low to moderate-income to avoid foreclosure, preserve their homes, and prevent homelessness on Long Island.



What We Do

The Foreclosure Prevention Project is part of the HOPP (Homeowner Protection Program) network, a statewide coalition that includes HUD-certified housing counseling agencies. We may refer and/or collaborate with other HOPP funded agencies. Being part of the HOPP network allows us to work closely with each individual homeowner and their unique circumstances to address their housing needs.

The Foreclosure Prevention Project staff attorneys and paralegals assist homeowners with a wide variety of mortgage and/or foreclosure types including forward mortgages, reverse mortgages, HELOCs/2nd liens, tax foreclosures, HOA foreclosures, etc.

Clients must reside in the homes subject to foreclosure and have low to moderate income for Long Island, as annually set by HUD.
