The Nassau Suffolk Hospital Council (NSHC) will help with Medicaid applications on site at Law Services. (see below for schedule)

This service involves assistance with <u>NEW</u> applications for the <u>aged, certified blind, and</u> <u>certified disabled populations</u>. (This is different from the NSHC Navigator program located at other sites, which helps people apply for Medicaid based on MAGI rules through the online NY State of Health insurance marketplace.)

This program is designed to help those who are eligible for Medicaid based on non-MAGI rules complete the paper Access NY and Supplemental A applications that are submitted directly to the local districts.

Here are the programs that specially trained staff will be able to assist the aged, blind, and disabled populations apply through the local DSS offices:

- ✓ Medicaid (Non-MAGI)
- ✓ Medicaid with a Spenddown
- ✓ Medicaid for coverage of community-based long-term care services
- Medicaid for Institutionalized Persons who are applying for coverage of nursing home care
- ✓ Medicaid buy-in for working people with disabilities program
- ✓ Medicare Savings Program
- ✓ Medicaid for institutional care in a nursing home
